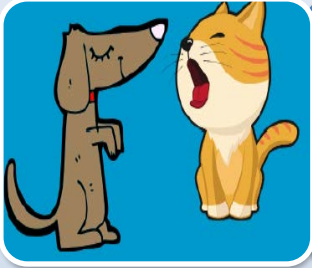




COVID 19 and Pet Owner FAQ



Q Can I get COVID-19 from my pet or other animals??

- **No there is no evidence that pet or other animals can spread the virus to humans.**
- **All transmission so far of COVID 19 is human to human via direct or indirect contact.**



Q. If owner get sick with COVID-19, could owner infect their pet animals?

- **We are still learning about this virus, but it appears that it can spread from people to animals in some situations.**
- **Avoid contact with your pet, including petting, snuggling, being kissed or licked, and sharing food or bedding..**



Q. If pet animal needs to be taken to the veterinarian and owner is infected with COVID-19 –What Should Owner do ?

- **Stay at home, minimizing contact with other people**
- **Seek assistance from your veterinarian to determine how to best secure your pet against infection.**



Q. Is there a COVID-19 vaccine for pet animals?

- **There is no vaccine for COVID-19 for animals or human at this time.**
