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COVID 19 and Pet Owner FAQ



- Q Can I get COVID-19 from my pet or other animals??
- No there is no evidence that pet or other animals can spread the virus to humans.
- All transmission so far of COVID 19 is human to human via direct or indirect contact.



- Q. If owner get sick with COVID-19, could owner infect their pet animals?
- ➤ We are still learning about this virus, but it appears that it can spread from people to animals in some situations.
- Avoid contact with your pet, including petting, snuggling, being kissed or licked, and sharing food or bedding.



- Q. If pet animal needs to be taken to the veterinarian and owner is infected with COVID-19 –What Should Owner do?
- Stay at home, minimizing contact with other people
- > Seek assistance from your veterinarian to determine how to best secure your pet against infection.



- Q. Is there a COVID-19 vaccine for pet animals?
- There is no vaccine for COVID-19 for animals or human at this time.
